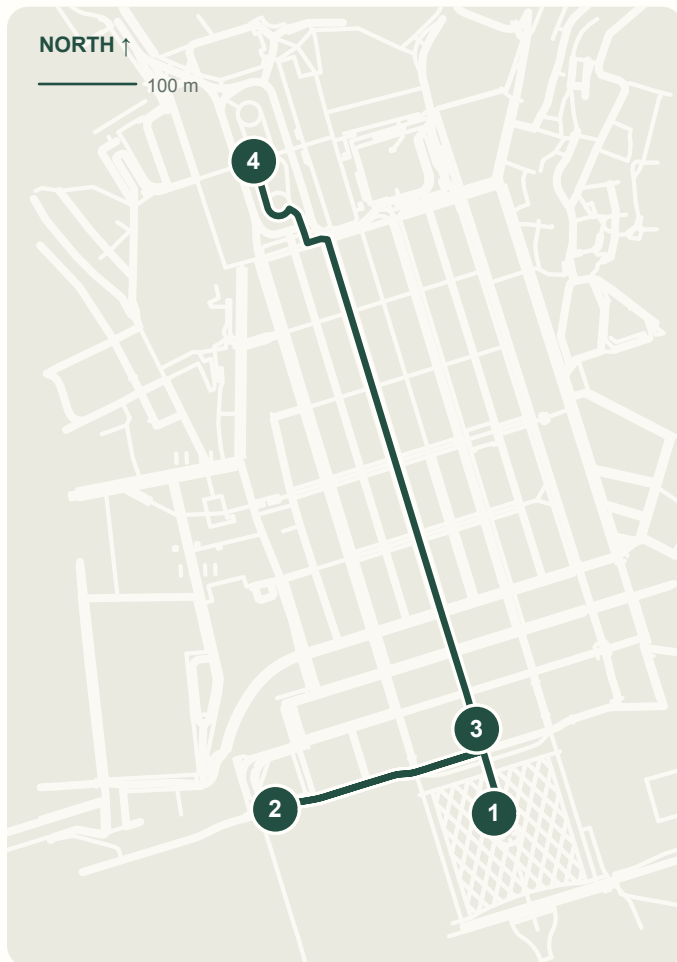


Three squares. Four stops.

BAIXA WALK · 1.2 KM, ONE WAY · ALLOW 45–75 MINUTES

An easy-to-carry route from the river to Rossio, with time for the details you might otherwise walk past.



01 Praça do Comércio

Start at the José I monument. Find the horse, then look for the elephant at the base.

02 Praça do Município

Look up at City Hall for the boat and two ravens in Lisbon's coat of arms.

03 Rua Augusta Arch

Pause beneath the arch at street level, then look north along Rua Augusta. The rooftop viewpoint is a separate ticketed visit.

04 Rossio

Finish in the square. Look for sculpted fish in the fountains and the wave-patterned paving.

Start: José I monument, Praça do Comércio.

Finish: Rossio square. This is an open route, not a loop.

Bring: water, shoes suited to stone paving, and the second page.

Desk-reviewed 9 September 2026. Not field-tested. Street works, crossings, curbs and step-free access need an on-the-day check.

Take the small streets.

DIRECTIONS & PRACTICAL NOTES

01 → 02 · PRAÇA DO COMÉRCIO TO MUNICÍPIO · 297 M

Face the arch from the monument. Move towards the northwest side of Praça do Comércio, then follow its western street connection to Praça do Município. Pause by City Hall and look for the boat and ravens. Watch for vehicles along the street edges.

02 → 03 · MUNICÍPIO TO RUA AUGUSTA ARCH · 246 M

Return east along Rua do Arsenal towards Praça do Comércio. Turn north onto Rua Augusta at the arch. This retraces part of the first leg. The mapped visit stays at street level; the rooftop viewpoint requires a separate ticket.

03 → 04 · RUA AUGUSTA ARCH TO ROSSIO · 670 M

Continue north on Rua Augusta, crossing the intersecting streets. At the far end, use pedestrian connections into Rossio square. Finish with the fountains and wave-patterned paving. Take extra time to explore either side of the square.

Before you go

The 1.214 km distance comes from the street-following pedestrian geometry. Allowing 45–75 minutes includes looking around and pauses; this is an editorial estimate, not a timed test. Expect stone paving, crossings and shared pedestrian spaces. Use marked crossings and follow current signs. On-site accessibility and temporary restrictions have not been checked.

Keep exploring

The Creature Safari uses the same squares. The original city audio guide covers a wider area and can be enjoyed during a pause. Download GPX for a compatible navigation app; the PDF itself does not provide turn-by-turn positioning.
