01 PRAÇA DO COMÉRCIO

I carry a king, but never move. Find my four legs above the square. What am I?

02 PRAÇA DO COMÉRCIO

Look at the base of the same monument. I have a long trunk. Can you find me among the stone details?

03 PRAÇA DO MUNICÍPIO

Look up at City Hall. Find the little boat. Two feathered travelers are aboard. What birds might they be?

Search the fountain sculptures. These creatures belong in water, but these ones are made of metal. What can you spot?

ANSWER SHEET · KEEP THIS SIDE A SURPRISE

Suggested ages 6–10, with adult help. This age range is editorial guidance. Allow about 45–75 minutes for the three squares, clues and pauses; this has not been tested with children or timed on site.

01 The horse

Praça do Comércio: the equestrian statue carries King José I. Ask your explorer how a motionless sculpture can suggest movement.

02 The elephant

Praça do Comércio: look around the sculptural group at the base of the José I monument. Stay outside barriers. A long trunk is the useful visual clue.

03 The ravens

Praça do Município: look up at the City Hall coat of arms. The boat and two ravens are part of Lisbon's emblem. Two birds count as one clue.

04 The fish

Rossio: look at the sculpted fish around the fountains. Let your explorer describe what they see; no need to guess a species.

Getting between the squares

Start at Praça do Comércio, walk west to Praça do Município, then return towards Rua Augusta and continue north to Rossio. The companion Baixa walking PDF supplies a street map and directions. Use marked crossings and check access on the day. Stone paving may be uneven or slippery.
